- A proportion of each country's gross national income

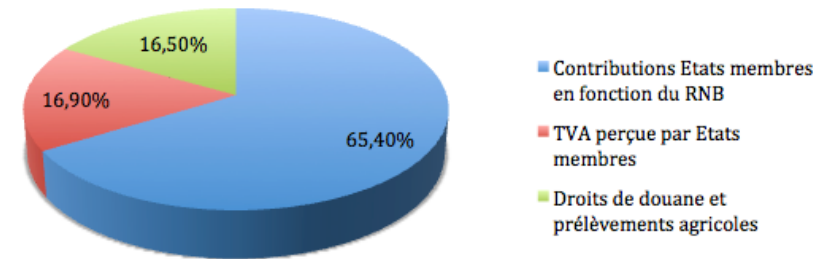


- Customs duties on imports from non-EU countries

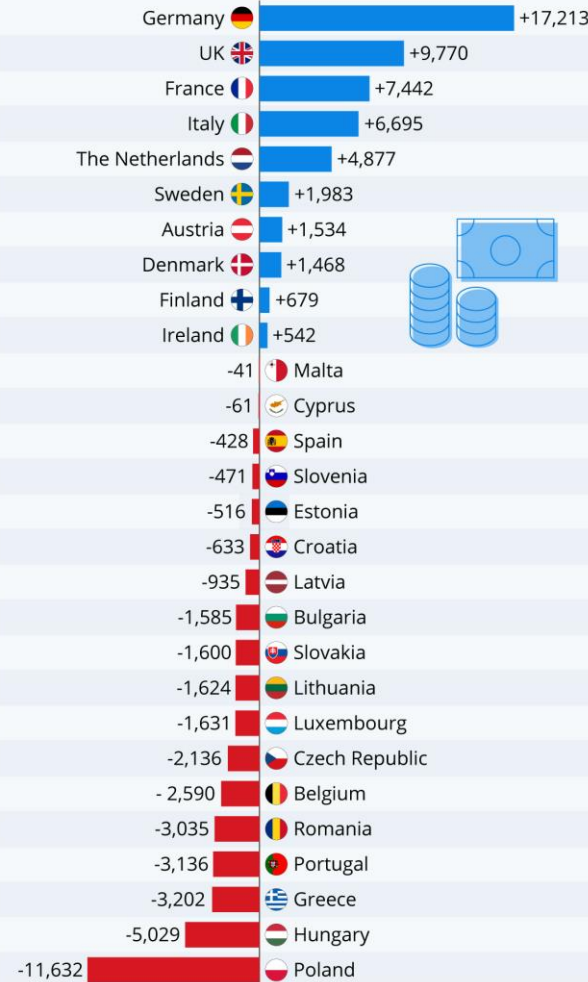


Contributors and beneficiaries of the EU

Net contributions to the EU budget, by member state (2018, in million euros)*

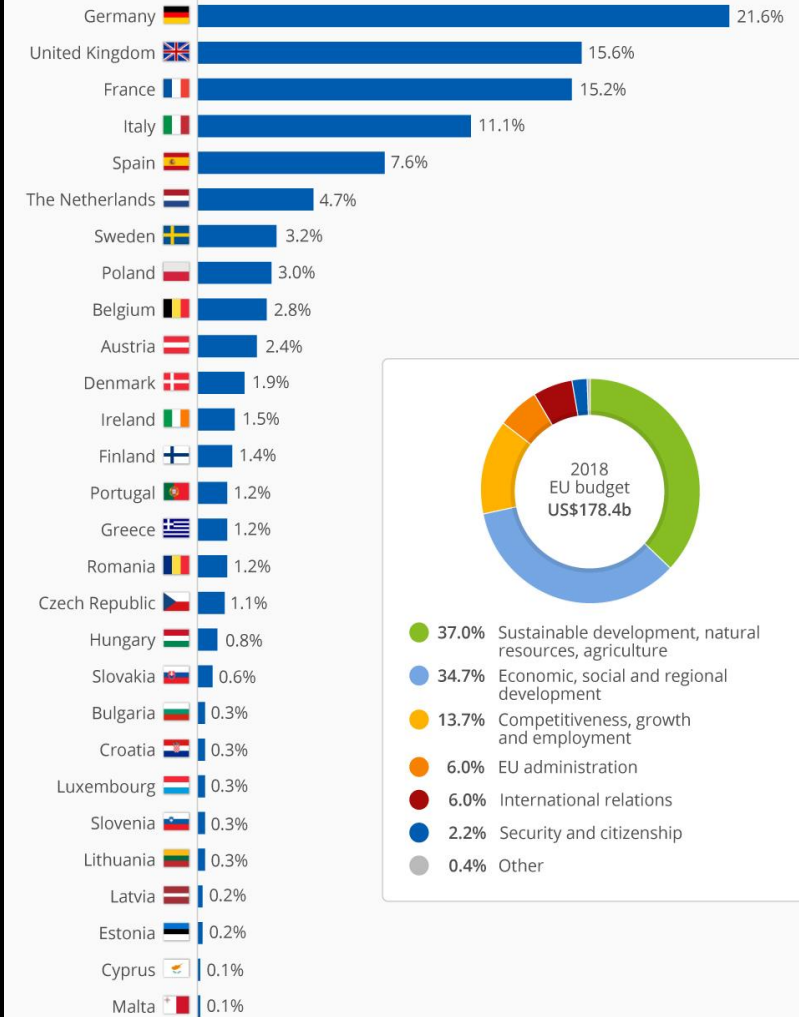


* contributions minus money received

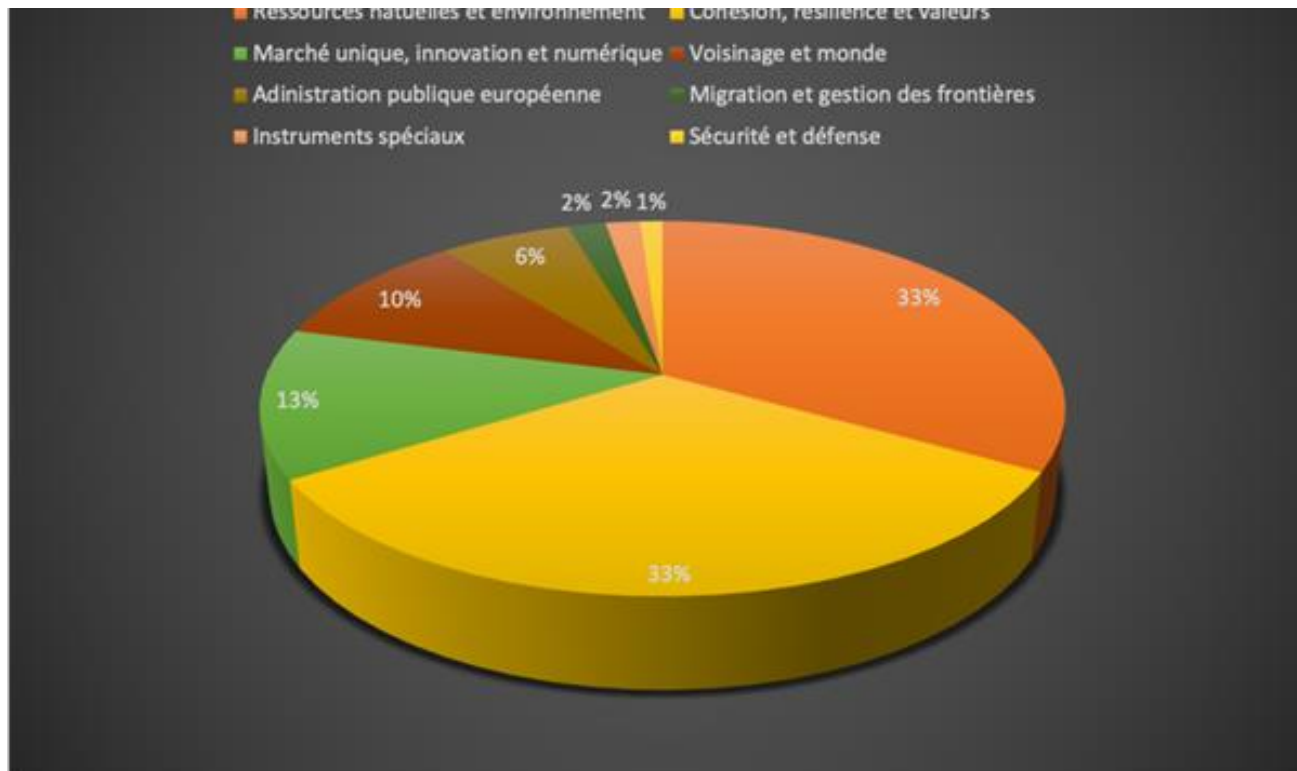
How Much are Member States Contributing to the EU?

Member state contributions to 2018 EU budget



- 37.0% Sustainable development, natural resources, agriculture
- 34.7% Economic, social and regional development
- 13.7% Competitiveness, growth and employment
- 6.0% EU administration
- 6.0% International relations
- 2.2% Security and citizenship
- 0.4% Other

What is the EU budget spent on ?



- Common agricultural policy : 33%
- Cohesion policy : 33%
- Research and innovation : 8%
- External action : 7,5%
- Strategic investments : 3%
- Erasmus mobility program : 2%
- Administrative costs : 6%
