

Western sanctions against Russia, restrictions on Russian gas and oil






Ukraine: support of the West (US and EU)

#### **DISPUTED TERRITORIES**

-Economic impact

-Population and labour impact

### **MUTUAL DISTRUST**

-Ukrain doesn't trust russian promises

-Russia fears incerclement by NATO



### **RISK OF ESCALATION**

-War could directly involve NATO

-Possible use of nuclear weapons



### INTERNATIONAL POLITIC DIMENSION

-For Vladimir Putin, retreat will be seen as a defeat

-For Ukraine, ceding territories would be seen as betrayal
