During the module 'Fiscal Policy and Inequality', we looked at different taxes and duties and their potential use as a tool in government policy. Your subject for this exam is:

Method:

- 1. Explain the problem
- 2. Make **clear propositions** for government policy using all the taxes and duties you think useful
- 3. Provide a PESTEL analysis on the **implementation of your propositions**Include economic concepts dealt with in class that might be useful (see 'contents' on the website).
- 4. Provide a personal conclusion on the difficulties / likelihood of your propositions being implemented

Format:

- 1. Write in English (preferably United Kingdom English)
- 2. There is no maximum or minimum number of words
- 3. Make a cover page with your name, course title (Economics Workshops, Resit Exam), date and teacher
- 4. Use the academic writing skills studied during the module (the use of referencing, footnotes, quotations etc.) (see 'Academic writing guidelines' lesson 12).
- 5. Since you only have 2 hours for the exam, you probably won't have time to do any research, so a bibliography is not necessary, but if you do find data, don't forget to add the source.
- 6. Save the document in pdf format before sending it to ESSCA

Evaluation grid:

- 1. Explanation of the problem: 3 points
- 2. Propositions: 5 points
- 3. PESTEL analysis: 5 points
- 4. Use of economic concepts: 3 points
- 5. Conclusion: 2 points
- 6. Use of academic writing protocol: 2 points

Reminder: what I am looking for is an intelligent understanding of Fiscal Policy as a tool. You probably won't have time to find data, but you can show, via your proposals and PESTEL analysis, that you understand the overall concepts.
