
Context of the Green Deal

IPCC - Intergouvernemental Panel on Climate change

- warning us the need to act
- 2018 : report the temperature contained to 1.5°C to limite extreme events
- Protocole Kyoto 1997 action beginning
- EU most polluting countries

2019: EU committed to become carbon neutral by 2050

Before 2030: 55% reduction in emissions



What is the EU green deal concretely?

2011 - goal set by the European Commission December 2019 - confirm member states EU green deal - set of initiatives to put them on a green transition



becoming carbon neutral by 2050 with 55% reduction in emissions by 2030





July 2021: Fit for 55 adopted proposals pack - to achieve the climate target of 55% emission reduction by 2030 impact everyone



FIT FOR 55


These proposal are:

- Climate action climate neutrality by 2050

- Sustainable industry carbon tax to some countries
- Sustainable agriculture
- Biodiversity protect ecosystem and species
- From farm to fork more respectful food system

- Eliminiating pollution
- Sustainability mobility green transport





Budget mobilized for the EU's Green Deal



public and private investments raise at least 1 trillion euros

Countries opposed to the green deal: Mainly Europe central



Why?

- dependant on fossil fuels
- financial cost very high

Example: Poland

- most coal-dependant member states
- one of biggest polluters
- first who didn't signed
