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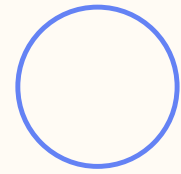

The programme is intended for students who wish to follow part of their curriculum in a partner educational institution that has signed an ERASMUS+ inter-institutional agreement with ESSCA

What is the Erasmus+ program?



Is the addition of two major programmes of the European Commission: the Lifelong Learning Programme and the Youth in Action programme.

The Erasmus+ programme aims to support actions with financial assistance in the fields of education, training, youth and sport

It gives students, teachers and administrative staff the opportunity to spend time abroad
