WHAT IS THE ERASMUS PROGRAM?

University-to-University Exchange Program

Major European schools and educational institutions around the world.

Mobility for education and training

Cooperation
between
organisations and
institutions

Support for policy development and cooperation

Offer scholarships to finance travel or exchanges

TO WHOM ARE THE SCHOLARSHIPS ACTUALLY DISTRIBUTED?

Numbers:

- 39% of erasmus students in France are on social criteria
- 59% of the beneficiaries of vocational training come from a popular backgrounds
- 1/3 of "vocational training" trainees have been enrolled in the employment pole for more than a year at the time of their mobility
- 1/4 benefited from vocational integration monitoring



WHAT PROBLEMS DO APPLICANTS HAVE WITH THE ERASMUS PROGRAMME?

Students from privileged backgrounds who have already had the opportunity to travel are most likely to go on erasmus.

Not all erasmus experiences have the same value or impact on a CV.
