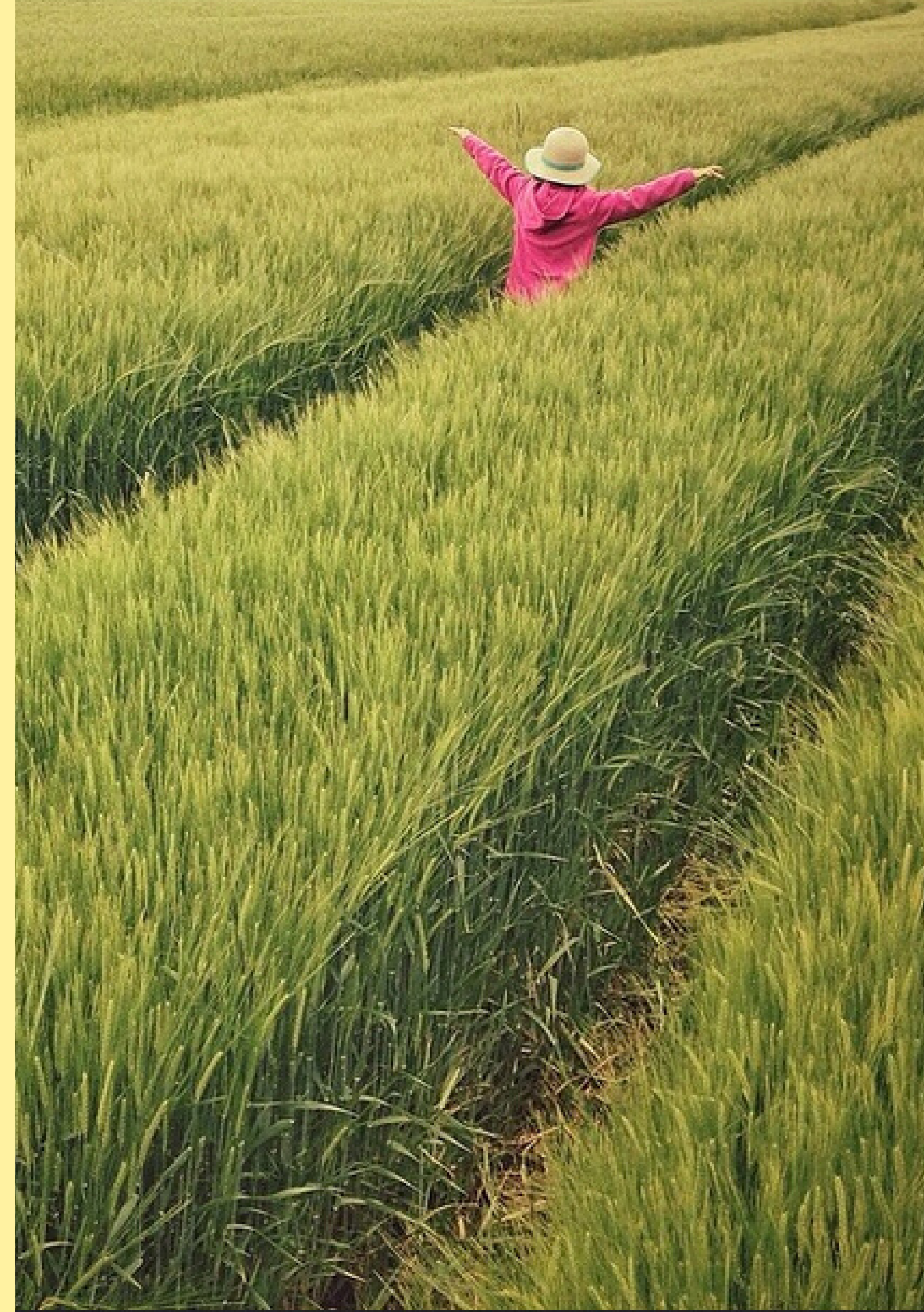
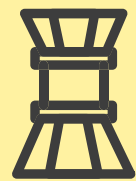

## Common Agriculture Policy

Based on the Treaty of Rome. Respond on the need of intervention and collaboration on the sector of agriculture.

Unify and collaborate to make agriculture viable.

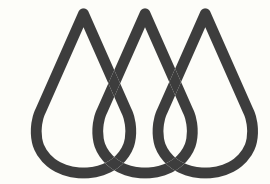


# What are the objectives of CAP ?

- \*To ensure reasonable prices for consumers.

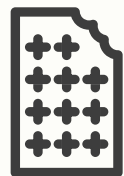






# Have those objectives been achieved ?
