



### 1. What is CAP briefly?

#### **Common Agricultury Policy**

Based on the Treaty of Rome. Respond on the need of intervention and collaboration on the sector of agriculture.

#### Problem: agriculture is unstable

Depends on geography, season, weather. Leads to a lote of fluctuation, and gives a lot of power to farmers

#### Solution

Unify and collaborate to make agriculture viable.

\* To increase agricultural productivity by promoting technical progress and ensuring the optimum use of the factors of production, in particular labor;

\*To ensure a fair standard of living for farmers

\*To stabilize markets

\*To ensure the availability of supplies

\*To ensure reasonable prices for consumers.
