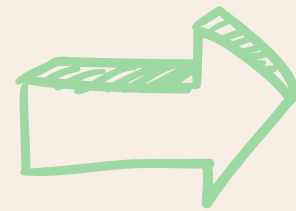

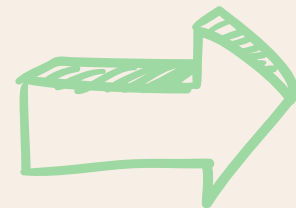

1945



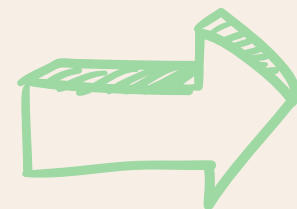
Thousands of dead, wounded and deported

➤➤➤ *Three key policies: Tariffs, quotas and minimum prices on imports*

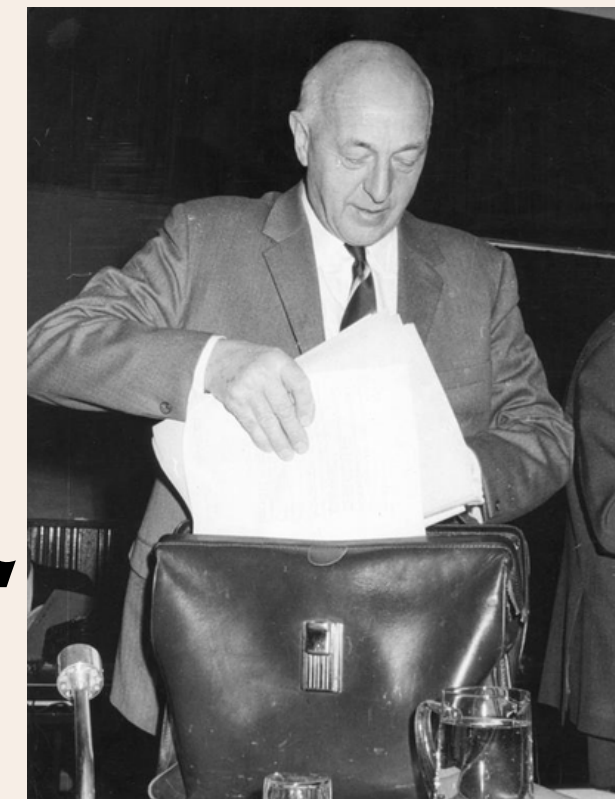


III. What are the important historical dates of the CAP?

1999: Addition of rural development



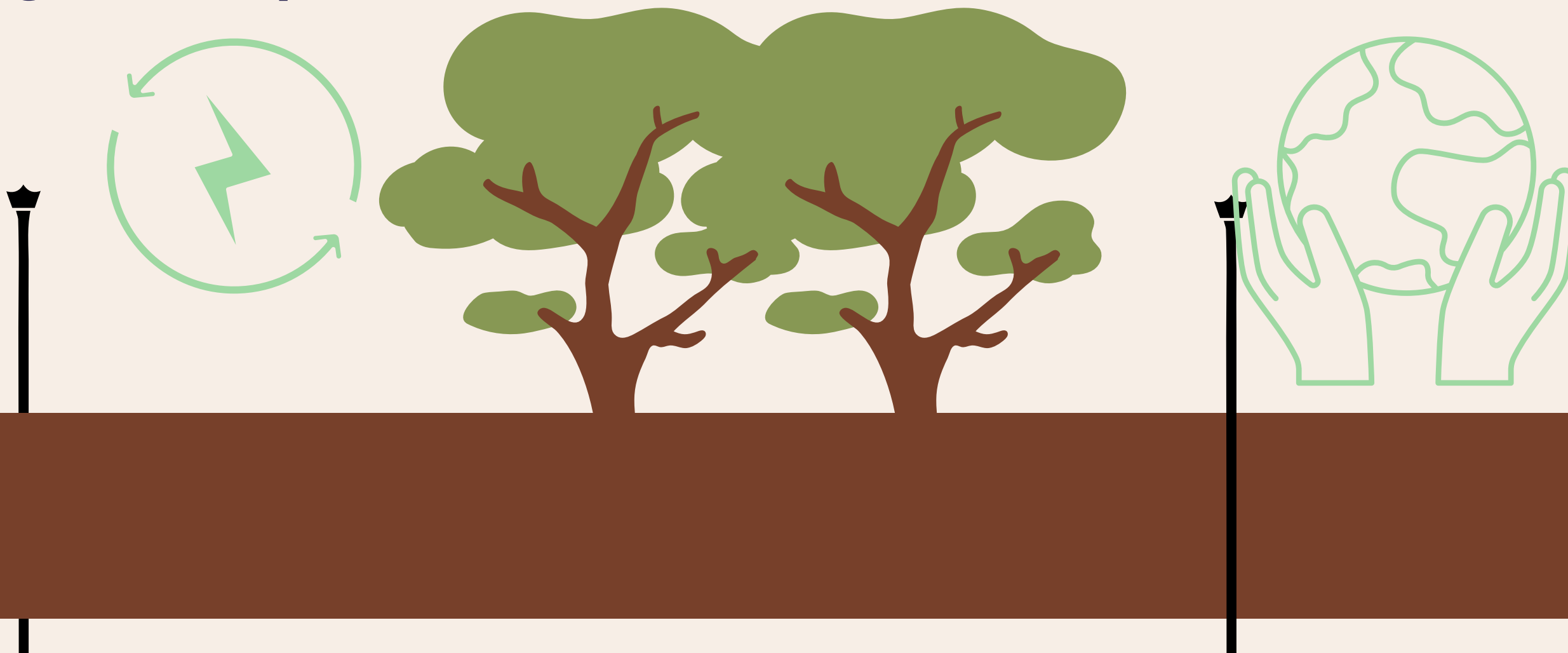
CAP= almost 50% of the total

2021: A fairer, greener and more results-oriented policy



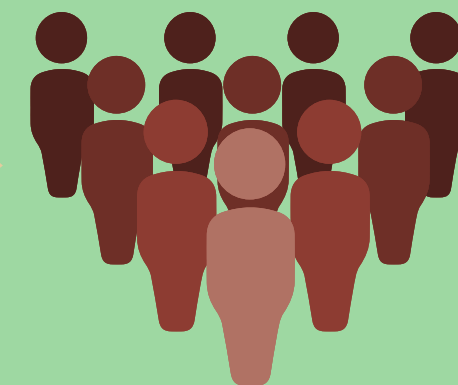

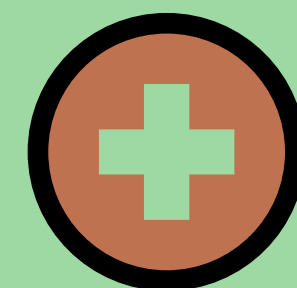
