The Brexit

- *This word is the abbreviation of the expression British Exit*
- *In the summer of 2016, in a vote, 52% of British people decided to leave the EU*
- *The European Union and the United Kingdom signed a trade and cooperation agreement on December 30, 2020, which applies from January 1, 2021*

The changes brought about by the Brexit

- At the European level, the fishing industry generates 3.7 billion euros in turnover, 107,000 jobs in fishing, 80,000 in aquaculture and 100,000 in processing.
- In 2020, following intense negotiations, an agreement was finally reached with the United Kingdom
