



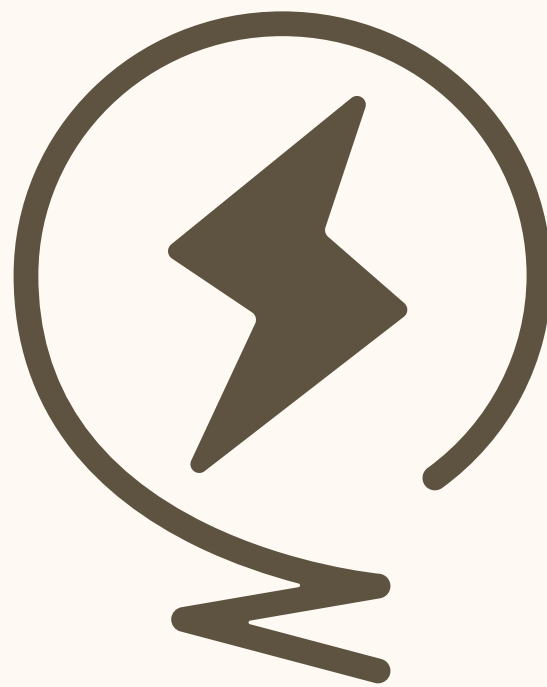

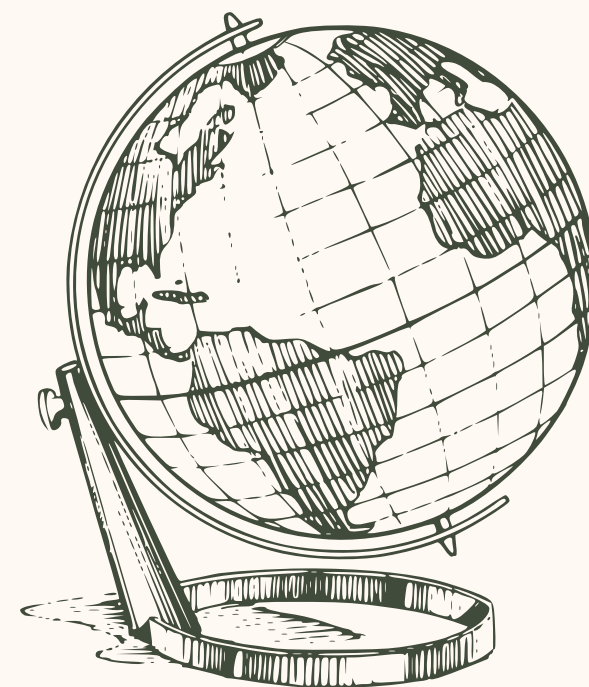

REDUCTION OF EMISSIONS

Reduction of emissions by 20% since the 1990s thanks to strict regulation

FOOD LAWS

Food products must be traceable
No insecticides and chemical

FARM TO TABLE STRATEGY MAY 2020

Part of the Green Deal
Goal: to reduce by 55% emissions of greenhouse gas

Advantages

Local products, good quality, better health, local production

Allow the developpement of the agricultural sector

Control:

NO DISCHARGE OF SUBSTANCES

No discharge of substances in the
air, water or soil

TRADE IN OZONE- DEPLETING SUBSRTANCES

(sales prices too)

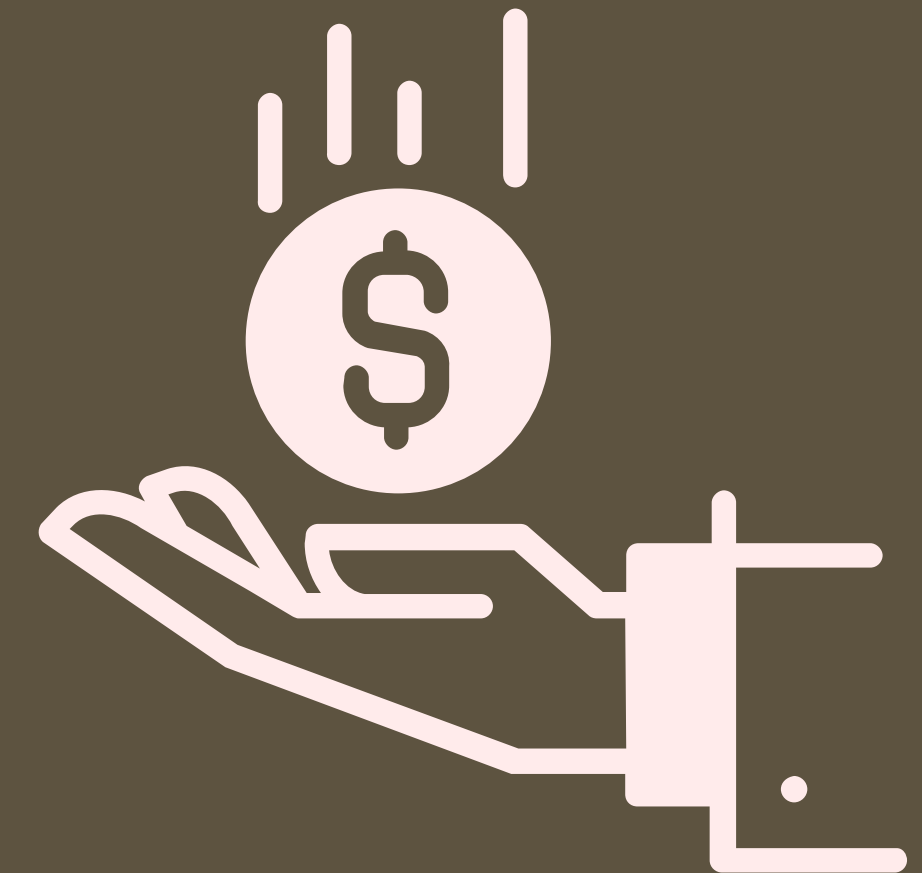
PRODUCT OF THE WORLD

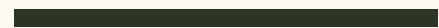
