Fabricated videos. Voice cloning. Synthetic media.

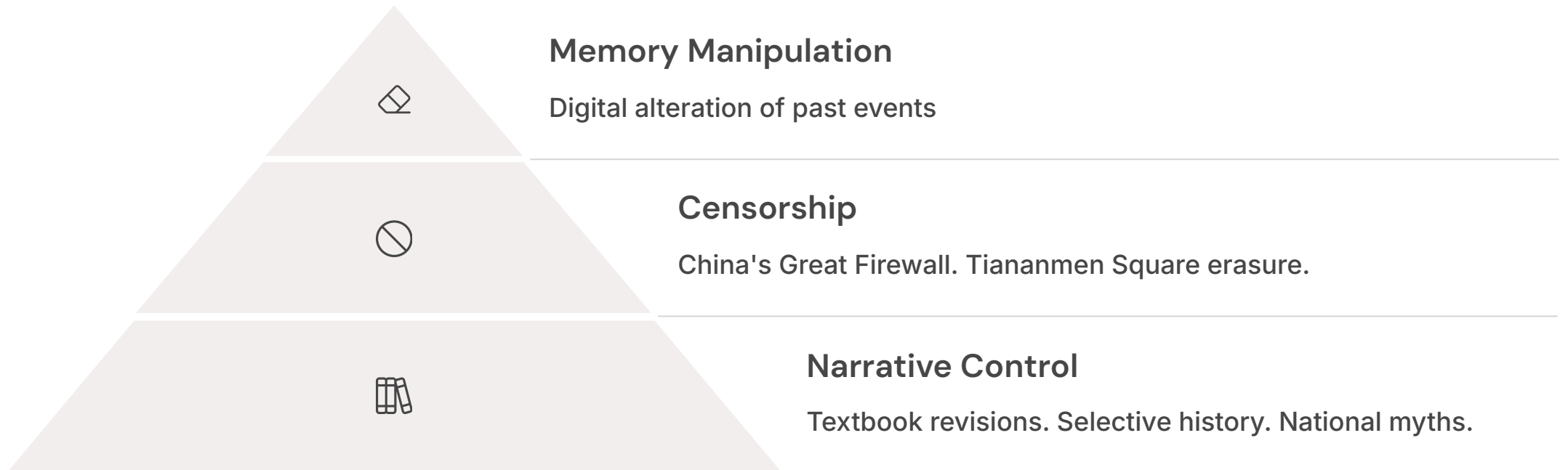
