

Q: Do you want Turkey to be part of the EU?




Source: All figures are from CAP's nationwide poll of Turkey conducted by the Turkish polling firm Metropoll. The survey is based on 2,534 face-to-face interviews with Turks using stratified sampling and weighting methods in 28 provinces. Seventy percent of in-person respondents are then called by phone to verify the data. The survey was conducted May 24 through June 4, 2018. Total results have a margin error of 1.95 percent at the 95 percent level of confidence.






EU Opinion on Turkish membership





Turkish Coup attempt in 2016



Soldiers involved in the coup surrender on the Bosphorous brige. Many Turkish citizens took to the streets to oppose the coup. 300+ killed. 2,100 injured. Supposedly started by the Gülen movement, but no clear evidence.

Post 2016 Coup Attempt

- 1/3 of all civil servents under investigation
- 150,000 civil servents fired
- 97,000 civil servents arrested
- 3,000 schools, student housing and universities closed
- 6,000 university teachers without work
- 189 media sources closed
- 319 journalists arrested
- 4,463 judges and lawyers fired

Turkey today and the future

The Turkish pound in constant collapse. See XE (currency reserves -ve)

Trade: Exports. Oil, gold, iron, cars, lorries, fabrics, clothing. Mostly to Germany, UK and USA (see export countries)

Trade: Imports. Fuel, gems and precious metals, machinery, vehicle parts, iron and steel

Energy: 44 % sustainable, mostly hydroelectric. Searching for new drilling sites.

Agriculture: considerable potential – but extracting water from rivers supplying other countries (Euphrates).


The Istanbul Canal Project. A 20bn \$ 45Km tanker route. Strongly opposed by environmentalists (opposition repressed) and many other countries.

The planned Istanbul Canal





Tread carefully!

Turkey has played a strong political rôle in North Africa, and its trade is moving towards MENA and away from the EU, but with Turkey's Customs Union with the EU, the EU remains the main commercial partner, and Turkey is the fifth biggest trade partner of the EU.

75 % of all FDI is from the EU.
