




CONCENTRATION OF EXECUTIVE POWER

Extended powers of the President:

Dissolution of the National Assembly on (June 2024) after the European elections

Use of Article 49.3 (used 106 times since 1958)

Major influence in international relations often sidelining the power of Parliament





DECLINE IN CITIZEN **PARTICIPATION**

Abstention in the 2022 legislative elections:
Reflecting a deep crisis of citizen trust in their representatives

Social movements (Yellow Vests):

In 2018-2019 287,000 participants, more than 60 weeks

FIRST ROUND

53,77 % 57,35 % SECOND ROUND





INEQUALITIES AND SOCIAL TENSIONS

<u>Under-representation of minorities:</u>

In 2022, only 4.6% in the National Assembly were from minority backgrounds, far actual proportion of minorities in France

Territorial divides:


In 2020, 85% of senior officials were from the Paris region, reinforcing the perception of centralization





Impact of fake news: In 2021, an IFOP study found that 36% of French citizens believed fake news on social networks, fueling distrust towards institutions

Polarization of opinions: A 2022 Reuters Institute survey found that only 29% of French citizens trust the media, making democratic debate more challenging
